The Great Lakes Interagency Task Force (11 Federal Agencies) has developed a plan to put into action President Obama’s historic **Great Lakes Restoration Initiative**, the largest investment in the Great Lakes in over two decades. This action plan covers fiscal years 2010 through 2014 and addresses five urgent problems:

- Cleaning up toxic areas
- Combating invasive species
- Promoting near shore health by protecting watersheds from polluted run-off
- Restoring wetlands, forests, rivers and streams
- Working with partners on outreach
